The Supervising Public Health Microbiologist (PHM) position directs a busy section of microbiologists in the public health laboratory; acts as a consultant on test result interpretations; is directly responsible for the operation and staff of the section in the laboratory; and performs additional fiscal and personnel duties in the absence of the Lab Director.

The County of San Diego Public Health Lab is the third largest county public health lab in California. We receive over 60,000 specimens a year and run over 80,000 tests each year. There are also applied research opportunities available for the right individual.

Education and experience:

1. Current certification as a Public Health Microbiologist issued by the State of California, OR a letter from the California Department of Health Services indicating that the applicant has passed the state Public Health Microbiologist certification examination; AND
2. A bachelor's degree with a major in Microbiology or a closely related field; AND
3. At least five (5) years of experience performing highly complex microbiology or immunology tests in a public health laboratory or in a laboratory that is certified by or exempt from the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendment of 1992, and must have included one (1) year of lead work experience.

Note: A master's or a doctorate degree from an accredited U.S. college or university, or a certified foreign studies equivalency with a major in Microbiology or a closely related field, may be substituted for one and two years of experience, respectively. Experience must be within the last ten (10) years.
